MC2025 Update- Kevin long

- The MC2025 Committee is finishing up with writing and developing the plan.
- B.O.T. has 3 major charges:
 - o Inclusiveness through the process.
 - o To be data informed.
 - o To have 5 or 6 Goals focused on academic success, engagement, and financial stability.
- MC2025 Committee meets every week.
- The B.O.T. held 2 community roundtables, 6 community café sessions with 300 stakeholders involved.
- 6 draft goal ideals are available for public feedback on Montgomery College's website. The goal ideals will remain open indefinitely.
- 14 campus and community forums will take place between now and June.
- 1st draft of the strategic plan for the B.O.T. is scheduled for April and looking to have the final strategic plan draft for the B.O.T. in June.
- 7 P&P's are currently out for public comment.
- Telework has been completely rewritten and given the new name flexible work arrangements. This includes telework, alternative work schedule, and remote work.

ASC Recommendation #1- Joel Levine

Joel Levine motioned to identify and review engagement, outreach and accessibility approaches for the Amharic-speaking community to address gaps in effectiveness in supporting student success. This review could be used to create a model for supporting other linguistic communities at Montgomery College Shane Doyle seconded the motion.

Joel Levine motioned to create a series of professional development workshops or training sessions that offer brief introductory conversational foreign language courses through ELITE for employees. Shane Doyle seconded the motion and motioned to amend the motion by striking out "through ELITE." Tracee Matthias seconded the motion amendment.
