# Environmental Health and Occupational Safety Steering Committee – Marvin Mills, VP of Facilities and Security

- The National Safety Council conducted a safety management system assessment at Montgomery College the week of October 23-27, 2017 and evaluated the effectiveness of the College's current safety and environmental system. Assessment is every five years.
  - The findings show that the College has some room for improvement.
  - The assessment provided safety assessment matrix, formal report, and action plan.
  - One of the recommendations is to establish a task force to accomplish the goals of the assessment and manage the action plan. Subcommittees are needed for specific actions.
  - o The task force will present reports to PEC on an annual basis.

#### Subcommittees:

- Chemical and Physical Hazards Subcommittee started in February 2021. Steering committee sponsor is the Dean of Chemistry & Biosciences.
- Occupational Safety Subcommittee started in February 2021. Steering committee sponsor is the Vice President for Facilities.
- Community Health Subcommittee will start in fall 2021. Steering committee sponsor is the Dean of Nursing & Health Sciences.
- Biosafety & Infectious Materials Subcommittee will start in fall 2021. Steering committee sponsor is the Dean of Chemical & Biological Sciences.
- Emergency Operations & Recovery Subcommittee will start in fall 2021. Steering committee sponsor is the Public Safety/Health Emergency Management.

- Obtained safety training resources at no additional cost to the College
- Established great working relationships with the safety team in the Office of Risk Management of Montgomery County
- Used existing county contract for chemical inventory database used by the College
- Obtained access to the BRIT learning system and training modules at no additional cost to the College
