#### Student Experience Survey - Dr. Monica Brown

Dr. Monica Brown was looking for feedback on a survey that will soon be launched to receive feedback from students about their student experience on campus.

Feedback Comments:

- Question 1g: clarify where the "there" is
- Question 2: ask if students would like to see Open Gym hours online
- Question 2: ask if students would like and use a swimming pool
- Question 3: ask if students feel safe in the parking garage (Takoma Park Silver Spring's parking garage is not on campus)
- Question 4: Include a consideration with utilities in mind
- Question 5: clarify that more than one option can be selected
- Question 5: ask what is the most used form of transportation to MC (instead of just from home)
- Question 8: add a question including online classes
- Question 9: include a "not sure" or "would prefer not to share"
- Question 9: include a select all that apply.
- Question 10: include a "prefer not to answer"
- Question 10e: spell counseling correctly
- Question 10e: Add "personal counseling" services.
- Question 10f: Add an optional answer box explaining an emergency situation
- On question 11f: Add (including physical and mental)
- Question 11c: Add academically unsatisfied

- Question 11: Add other option, with optional answer box
- Question 15: Add optional other box
- Question 20: What if you're providing financial support for people you're not living with?
- Question 20: Add not providing financial support to anyone (not even yourself)

### Student Email Update and Management System Identification - Mr. Dang

Mr. Dang discussed the changes about to be made to office 365 student email accounts. The changes are planned to be launched near the middle or end of November. The changes are being made to the "background" system, so the changes may not be significantly different to the eye. One of the main issues is that some students have not been able to get an office 365 email account.

Changes with the new Launch:

- When "forgot password" is selected:
  - More modern looking screen
  - Faster and more efficient
  - Screen is able to be fitted to a mobile device's screen
  - Option to enter phone number and receive a code to reset password (Current system makes student call help center for around 30 minutes)
- Email account expires three years after last class date (Current system expires after two years)
- My MC account will expire after five years from the last interaction on the account

• If a preferred name is entered, the preferred name will apply to the email account (not yet applied to my MC account)

## Equity and Inclusion Update - Dr. Sharon Bland

Dr. Sharon Bland presented the "Operating Plan for the Office of Equity and Inclusion" PowerPoint presentation. The presentation discussed the charge of the office, which focused on ten critical areas of work. The presentation also discussed the I.D.E.A.L.S. framework and went over the goals to be accomplished in 2017-2018.

- When do you take the shuttle most often? How crowded is the shuttle at that time?

• Have you ever observed your bus driver speaking or using a phone while driving?
