Welcome - Call to Order

• The Student Council meeting was called to order by Rebecca Adegeye at approximately 3:05 PM.

Constituent Concerns

- Jonathan Alfaro shared thoughts on the college's spring commencement plans. He shared how he believes that the county's current COVID-19 conditions seem sufficient to host graduates and their families instead of just graduates for commencement ceremony.
- After meeting with Dr. Dukes, it was decided that the best option now would be to only allow graduates at the spring commencement ceremony. The decision was based on recommendations, COVID-19 statistics, and an acknowledgment of how fast changes can occur in the county.
- Must keep in mind that commencement is usually planned 9-12 months ahead

Recommendation:

- In April, invite members of the graduation committee to answer any lingering questions some may have about commencement
- Have graduation committee members at the meeting give updates on how the commencement ceremony is being planned

Discussion with Rockville Campus Director of Facilities: Marv Mills

Objective

- Share and address previous meeting constituent concerns about the size of classrooms and its potential risk to the spread of COVID-19
- How student council and campus operations team can work together to produce a solution for the future
- Last Month, Kevans Faustin brought up a concern about the assignment of certain classrooms being disproportionate to the number of students taking the class. Some classrooms are smaller yet hold many students, a potential concern for COVID-19 social distancing and safety guidelines.

Notes from Mary Mills

- Senior administration set up a group called the Return to Campus Advisory Team, and they monitor what is going on in Montgomery County in terms of the number of deaths, cases, hospitalization, etc.
- County has seen tremendous improvement and is scaling down on social distancing measures, and mask mandates but the college continues with its mask mandate and continues to recommend vaccination
- Return to Campus Advisory Team meets every week, and Kevans concern will be brought up and addressed at the meeting
- Professors can bring these types of concerns to their deans and to their campuses registrar to see where more space is available, whether it be that building or another building on campus
- Next Return to Campus Advisory Meeting: March 9th @ 3 PM
- Rockville Campus Dean, Dr. Kelley, is on the team and Mr. Mills will see what Dr. Kelley can do to intervene in the matter

• Job is centered around students, would love to come back to talk about any concerns or comments from students in the future

Group Discussion: College Councils Two Goals

- Need to decide the projects that the council will take on for the semester
- About halfway through the semester with limited time, the virtual options may be best
- Rebecca has been in contact with Ms. Hannah Stocks, Germantown Service-Learning Facilitator, and she has been giving suggestions and feedback on the two goals
- Community activities centered around social media campaigns seem to be the most doable, everyone must reflect on their strengths and weaknesses and see how they can contribute to match other strengths
- Many had experience with speaking to children about volunteering and civic engagement, which could be a potential project
- Rebecca Adegeye will follow up with everyone on the process of accessing the website and how to thoughtfully plan the execution of projects, information was given by Ms. Stocks

College Governance Recruitment Idea

- Potential plans to recruit more people to the Student Council from inperson events
- Decided it was best to focus on the Rockville campus during lunch since that is the area and time where the most traffic is seen
- Would need to request tables and time slot for the recruitment taking place on the open space in the middle of the Rockville campus
- MC merch could be given out as prizes, helping convince people to come over to the tables
- More recruitment can be done at the other campuses after the Rockville campus
- Perhaps have two tables in two separate locations?
- Finalize idea during next meeting since more people will be present and it is early enough so that it can be executed at the end of the month
