Covid-19 Discussion

- Will students continue to get paid from MC?
 - Possible reassessment on April
 - Will bring-up at PEC daily meeting
- Discuss on reallocation funds requests
- Student Senate is investigating pass/fail for this semester.
 - There is a significant downside to this approach (transfer not accepted, course not factored in GPA)
- Mid-term grades extended to April 10th
- Not every student is an online student (remote vs. distance learning, disabilities, other barriers)
- Not all faculty are prepared to teach online, so they are being as flexible as possible
 - Training offered
 - Work with DSS counselors to understand remote accommodations
