


















Communities we serve and aspire to serve

The percentage of the top 50 occupations that employers had the most difficulty filling in 2020 that required some form of postsecondary education.




The percentage of all new jobs between 2020 and 2030 that will require some form of postsecondary education.















Presidential Transition Advisory Committee (PTAC) Presidential Transition Work Model (April–September 2022)
