NOTES: The Bachelor of Science Nursing for Registered Nurses (BSN) major is available only to students who have an associate degree in nursing or a diploma from a registered nursing education program that is recognized by the appropriate state board of nursing, and the student must reside in and have an active, unencumbered nursing license in an approved state (see *umgc.edu/nursing* for the most up-to-date list of approved states) / Student is placed in Pre-BSN status at time of admission into the BSN program and remains in that status until completion of all Gen Ed and related requirement courses are completed / ~ = Per Maryland RN to BSN articulation model, associate degree nursing credits will not be transferred in the BSN degree plan−instead students are awarded 30 upper-level credits from their active, unencumbered RN license (acquired after passing the NCLEX) / Minimum of 120 credits, including 36 upper-level (courses numbered 300-499) required for bachelor's degree with minimum 2.0 (C) grade point average (GPA) / No course within major or minor below 2.0 GPA / At least one-half of credits within major and minor comprised of: a. upper-level; b. UMGC resident; c. traditional college courses earning a grade / Maximum of 70 transfer credits to UMGC from 2-year or community college (actual number of transfer credits dependent on meeting all UMGC bachelor degree requirements) / WRTG 112 completed with grade of 1.67 GPA (C-) or better / ◆ = Denotes course in major at UMGC / \* = Denotes lower-level course meets content requirement of upper-level course but does not transfer as upper-level / UL = Denotes upper-level course / + = Denotes course must be completed prior to converting from Pre-BSN status to the nursing for registered nurses major and prior to enrolling into NURS 300
