

Art & Design Studio Safety & Use Procedures

Level 1 - Low Risk: Drawing, 2D Design and Digital Fabrication Studio

The following Studio Safety Policies are applicable to Drawing and 2D Design studio classrooms collegewide, and are in addition to the General Art Studio Safety and Use Policy.

Note: Failure to adhere to these rules, or disrespect given to instructors, monitors, students or staff will result in the inability to use the studio during Open Studio times, in addition to other penalties determined by your instructors or the department chair.

FIXATIVES/HAIRSPRAYS AND PAINTS

Do

- Acrylic paint waste must be disposed of in trash prior to washing brushes and tools in the sink.
- Be mindful of airborne particles from charcoals, pastels, etc.

Do Not

- Do not use workable fixative or hairspray indoors or close to a door or window of a building when outdoors.
- Do not use oil paints in Drawing and 2D Design studios.

SHARPS

Do Not

- Do not leave Sharps on the floor or model stand (consult with staff for disposal of sharps).

PERSONAL PROTECTION EQUIPMENT (PPEs)

- Dust masks may be recommended when using media that create dust (such as charcoals and chalk pastels).
