



**Supply List – Tatiana Martin
Watercolor Techniques I – LLI609**

For this class, you will need the following materials:

1. Watercolor paper pad heavy weight 140 lb. size 9 x12 or 11x 14 (Strathmore or Canson brands are great choice)
2. Masking tape or blue painters tape
3. Note pad optional
4. Loose white paper to try techniques (any but not printing paper) few papers for each class
5. Watercolor set (pans or tubes) any brand (Winsor & Newton, Cotman or any other brands welcome)
6. Round brushes (large, medium and small for details) synthetic or natural
7. Few flat brushes synthetic (Artist's loft brand set of brushes from Michael's is adequate and typically includes all or almost all types)
8. Fan brush synthetic (often included in Michael's brush set)
9. Mixing tray (any) plus some white paper to try colors on
10. Water container 1 or 2
11. Colorless masking fluid for Watercolor
12. Natural Sea sponges 2-3 (Small pack from Michael's is a great choice)
13. Photographs (colored) to work with
14. Pencils HB
15. Eraser soft
16. Extra fine tip black sharpie or waterproof ink pen (Micron fine line set of 3 is suggested)
17. Few crayons (Crayola)
18. Scratching tool such as stylus tool, sewing needle, palette knife or any tool with small sharp edge
19. Salt (regular table salt) about 1 tbs Coshers salt suggested
20. Paper towels or napkins

Everything can be bought from an Art supply store such as Michael's Arts and Crafts or Plaza Art
